



TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. ELIGIBILITY

a) The competition is open to all players and clubs affiliated with the Portuguese Golf Federation, similar Golf Federations and members of a Club affiliated with the Northern Portugal Golf Association, with valid Handicap, according to the following age groups:

- Under-25 - Born between 01-01-1995 and 31-12-2001
- Under-18 - Born After 31-12-2001
- Under-16 - Born after 31-12-2003

b) According to the AGNP's By-Laws, the registration of non-FPG players or associated clubs of this AGNP (invited and/or International players) is accepted, provided that they fulfill the other conditions of the Regulations. These guest players will not be awarded the disputed titles, although they will be entitled to a specific trophy if they are ranked in the entitled places.

c) This competition is part of WAGR - WORLD AMATEUR GOLF RANKING. For WAGR purposes there will be two general strokeplay gross classifications - one male and one female.

2. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND DATES

a) REGISTRATION METHOD: exclusively via online form (available on dedicated page at <https://agnp.pt>)

b) LIMIT DATE: Until 23:59 hours of July 19, 2020.

c) HOST: AMARANTE Golf Course

d) FEE:

- 20 Euros per AGNP member club member player.
- 35 Euros per player who is a FPG member but not a member of an AGNP club.
- **45 Euros per international player belonging to FPG counterpart Federation.**

NOTE: Does not include training lap, training balls or any means of transport for players, caddies or golf bags.

e) NUMBER OF ACCEPTED PLAYERS: For the Northern Portugal Youth Championship 2020, in the U25, U18 and U16 levels, up to 99 (ninety nine) players will be admitted, divided equally, by age group.

The Technical Commission reserves the right to change this limit in accordance with the step entries.

f) BOOKING: For the Northern Portugal Youth Championship 2020, in the U25, U18 and U16 levels, 20 entries are reserved to be managed by the following distribution:

- Non-AGNP Portuguese Golf Federation members - 8 seats
- Players affiliated with Federación Gallega de Golf - 2 places
- Players affiliated with Federación Cantabra de Golf - 2 places
- Players affiliated with the Castilla y Leon Golf Federation - 2 places
- Players affiliated with other similar Golf Federations - 6 places

NOTE: Preference will be given to players already integrated in WAGR in ascending order of handicap. If all reservations are not filled (by Federation), seats may be redistributed at the sole discretion of the Organization.

g) EXCLUSIONS: By age group, if the number of subscribers exceeds the established registration limit, the highest handicaps will be excluded. In order for the tournament to take place, a minimum of 3 players present on the exit tee are required per age group. If this is not the case then the player will have the opportunity to join the higher rank.

h) WITHDRAWALS: Any withdrawals after the release of Draw may be completed by registered players, within the deadline and date, following the same criteria stated, ie, in order of lowest handicap first, regardless of age. Withdrawals and absences from Competitions are regulated by Circular No. 1/2017.





i) **ADMISSION AND CONDITIONS:** For the purpose of accepting a player in the event, the respective handicap, which appears on the FPG server (or similar Federation) on the day of the closing of the registration will be considered.

It is the responsibility of each player to verify their correct and timely registration by consulting the Registrants on the AGNP website.

i) **WAITING LISTS:** The waiting list of registered players will be sorted in ascending order of handicaps by age group.

3. FORMAT

a) **DATES OF THE COMPETITION:** Tuesday 21 July until Thursday 23 July 2020:

b) **HOLES:**

- U25, U18 and U16: 54 holes in Strokeplay (18 holes per day)

c) **TEE'S:**

- U25: Boys - White / Girls - Blue
- U18: Boys - White / Girls - Blue
- U16: Boys - White / Girls - Blue

d) **HANDICAP:** For the U25, U18 and U16 competitions, the maximum EGA handicap is 36.

e) **DRAW:** Available on the dedicated competition page at <https://agnp.pt> from the day after the deadline for entries.

f) **AWARDS:**

- Absolute Champion and Absolute Vice Champion (all age groups - male and female), in Gross and Net.
- Champion and Vice Champion of each age group - male and female, in Gross and Net.
- 1st and 2nd Classified International / Guest - male and female, in Gross.

NOTE: There is no accumulation of Prizes (Only the Absolute, may accumulate with the respective age group). Gross prizes prevail before the Net by age group.

4. RESULT CARD DELIVERY

a) The player's scorecard is officially handed over to the Technical Commission when the player leaves the Scorecard area with both feet.

5. TIES

In case of a tie for the 1st place (and also for the title of Champion of the North of Portugal), the tie will be solved by "Sudden Death Play Off". For the remaining places, the tie will be broken successively by the best last 36, 27, 18, 9, 6, 3 holes, best last hole. If the tie persists it will be settled in favor of the highest handicap (gross) or the lowest handicap (net), and if the tie still persists it will be settled by lot.



6. COMPETITION RESULTS - COMPETITION CLOSED

a) When the results are posted on the local competition board, the competition results are officially announced and the competition closed.



7. RULES, TECHNICAL COMMITTEE AND REFEREES

a) **RULES:** Those approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the conditions set forth in the FPG Terms of Competition and Local Rules of Permanent Application, as well as the Additional Local Rules set forth by the Technical Commission.

b) **TECHNICAL COMMITTEE AND REFEREES:** They will be appointed in due course by AGNP.

c) The omissions in the Regulations will be decided definitively by the Technical Commission.
